"Crop Composition as a Component of Food and Feed Safety Assessment and Hands on with the ILSI Crop Composition Database" is the topic of one of the 6 workshops available to ISBR2019 participants on Tuesday, April 2. Andrew Roberts and Bhavneet Bajaj of ILSI Research Foundation, USA are the organizers of this hands-on session.

Crop composition is an essential component of the food safety assessment for GE crops that are intended to be used as food. However, it is important to understand the purpose of the data and its context in the safety assessment. This workshop will provide an opportunity to briefly discuss the rationale for considering crop composition data, how that data is interpreted in the context of the safety assessment and what the limitations are to compositional studies. ... more
