### Program \*\*\* Update \*\*\*

The <u>Preliminary Program</u> is now live on the ISBR website. It gives ISBR members a "first look" at the confirmed Keynote, Plenary, and Parallel session speakers. Dates/Times/Room information remains tentative, as the final program is built.

- Monday (Nov 3<sup>rd</sup>): The opening session will be followed by <u>Plenary I: Advancing</u>
  <u>Public Understanding and Support for Bio-Innovation</u>, with a Keynote address
  provided by Julie Borlaug. <u>Ten Parallel sessions</u> will run throughout the
  afternoon, covering Genome Editing in Plants, Gene Drives, Genetically Modified
  Crops, Capacity Building, Animal Biotechnology, Communicating Science, and
  other important topics. Five students were awarded the <u>ABSTC-ISBR student</u>
  <u>scholarship</u> and will present posters and participate in the Pecha Kucha session
  on Monday night, followed by a Poster Session with over 40 registered poster
  presenters.
- Tuesday (Nov 4<sup>th</sup>): A student breakfast and networking event will be followed by <u>Plenary II: Exploring Scientific Advancements, Opportunities, and Challenges</u> <u>in Bio-Innovation</u>, with a Keynote address provided by Steven Runo. <u>Five</u> <u>interactive workshops</u> will run throughout the afternoon, covering Genome Editing in Plants, Ethics and Evolution, Genetically Modified Crops, Animal Biotechnology, and Artificial Intelligence for Biosafety Research. A continuation of the Poster Session in the evening will allow you time to visit all the posters you missed on Monday! Please plan to attend the ISBR Members meeting to learn more about ISBR2027 and provide feedback.
- <u>Wednesday (Nov 5<sup>th</sup>)</u>: <u>Plenary III: Governance and Regulatory Frameworks</u>: <u>Understanding the Global Landscape</u> will start with a Keynote address by Rodomiro Ortiz. <u>Ten Parallel sessions</u> will run throughout the afternoon, covering Agricultural Biologicals, Regulatory Frameworks, Genome Editing in Plants, Gene Drives, Genetically Modified Crops, and other Bio-Innovation topics. The day will conclude with the **Symposium dinner**, which is a great networking opportunity for delegates to reconnect with colleagues and make new acquaintances.

- <u>Thursday (Nov 6<sup>th</sup>)</u>: <u>Plenary IV: Governance and Regulatory Frameworks:</u> <u>Understanding the Global Landscape</u> will start with a Keynote address by Renée Anderson, and will end with the ISBR closing session.
- Note: The optional tours of the VIB & BASF facilities or the VIB field trial location are fully booked !
